Overview

The NI PXIe-5105 high-resolution oscilloscope features eight 60 MS/s simultaneously sampled input channels with 12-bit resolution, 60 MHz bandwidth, and up to 512 MB of memory in a compact, 3U PXI Express module. This oscilloscope uses the NI Synchronization and Memory Core architecture, so you can combine multiple devices to build up to 136 phase-coherent channels in a single PXI chassis. You can also synchronize an NI PXIe-5105 with other analog and digital instruments to create mixed-signal test systems. This oscilloscope is ideal for a wide range of applications including ultrasonic nondestructive test, medical imaging, scientific research, military/aerospace, and consumer electronics.
